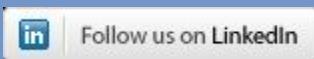

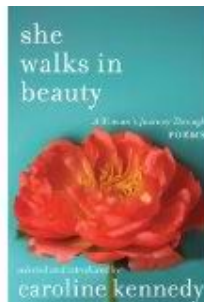
STEPHANIE KALIN MEMORIAL BOOK AWARD

THRIFT SHOP DONATIONS

Your gently used clothing, knickknacks, and small household items can make a difference for Needham neighbors in need.

The Council Thrift Shop is a fundraiser which helps support our other programs; including the food pantry, transportation programs, ESL tutoring, medical equipment loan closet, etc.

Donations to the Needham Community Council are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law and are either sold in our thrift shop or re-donated to others in need.

Your donated items can be dropped off in our downstairs hallway site where tax-exempt forms are available on a clipboard. ***If possible, please try to avoid dropping off your donations when our store is open on Wednesdays and Fridays.***

Clothing and household goods should be in good condition and working order...***would you give it to your neighbor? If so, please donate it to us.***

There are goods we cannot accept due to space limitations. Please visit the thrift shop page on our website. Call us if you are unsure of something you wish to donate. We can suggest other agencies if we cannot accept your items.
